NOTE ON THE AUTHOR

Aleksandar Diklić (Belgrade, March 7, 1970) is a Serbian composer, director and producer. His early music dealing has been marked by his work in a large number of musical studios in Belgrade. He participated in the production of numerous projects of popular music. He has independently composed and created the cult instrumental album My Alexandria, with the assistance of the Belgrade producer and close friend, Miloš Pavlović. The album was published by the Belgrade publishing agency "Komuna", in 1997.

The unusual music has been created after the author's pilgrimage to Jerusalem and Mount Athos.

My Alexandria contains the tracks: Jerusalem, Constantinople, Belgrade; Alexandria; the Kosovo fog; the Heavenly city; the Mirrors of the Time; Monastery; In the Time of the Great Sorrow, Father and Mountain.

My Alexandria is one of the most frequently broadcasted musical themes at the Serbian radio and TV stations, and the everlasting notes from this album with their dramatic nature serve as a basis to a large number of documentaries and cultural and educational programs.
